

This year, as we have multiple entrants in the eisteddfod, parents are expected to arrange transportation and supervision of their child for the individual and two-voice poems on their respective days. A teacher will be present each day, however, this is in a facilitator role, rather than that of a supervisor.

On the Tuesday, students who are not participating in the Infants Individual Poems will be transported to Narrabri for our school poem. Teachers will supervise for this day.

More information will be handed out at the poetry rehearsal.

#### **Kindergarten Transition**

Our 2018 Kindergarten Transition program will start next term. Unlike most schools who offer a 1-day Transition to Kindergarten, Pilliga Public School holds an extended transition for Terms 2 & 3. This program is aimed at students who are attending school in 2018, and is also extended to students who are turning 4 this year if their behavior is appropriate for the school environment. As always, our enrolled students are our first priority and we ensure that their learning is not disrupted. The next priority goes to students attending school in 2018, to ensure that they have few disruptions as they learn the way of the classroom and school life. Children turning 4 this year may attend half-days. Again, this will depend on their maturity and ability to follow instructions. As we all know, learning begins at home which is where you can teach your child the expected behaviours necessary to be involved in our school transition. This includes being able to sit, listen and engage in a story, follow simple directions and participate in shared games. All children will also need to be able to go to the toilet independently.

This program is not compulsory for schools to offer and we want to encourage positive experiences at school to maintain its success.
