Welcome Back to all our families, we are all looking forward to sharing 2019 with you, we are excited to introduce some new learning opportunities at Pilliga this year, such as a new investigative maths scheme, a fun wellbeing program, further development of the robotics program with some senior students competing in a national competition and also the creation of a new bush tucker garden with all students involved.

2019 Classes: Miss Wanford will be teaching the Infant class supported by Mrs Phelps and Maddie, Moday to Thursday (whole school Tuesday) with Mrs Stewart teaching the Primary class Monday to Friday (whole school on Friday)supported by Mrs Phelps. Miss Keenan will be teaching STEAM to the Infant class on Wednesday and the Primary class on Thursday and working on specific projects with certain students every second Friday.
